While many people see mosquitoes as nothing more than a nuisance, for millions of families across Africa, particularly in Nigeria, they represent something far more devastating. They are carriers of diseases that continue to rob families of their loved ones, children of their future, communities of productivity, and nations of economic growth.

OUR IMPACT JOURNEY (2024 – PRESENT)

Since the launch of our World *Mosquito* Day Initiative, we have continued to expand both our reach and our impact. With lessons from previous years, we amplified our reach. We moved from temporary relief to sustainable Integrated Pest Management (IPM).

Our activities have included:

- Community awareness campaigns on malaria prevention.

- Distribution of protective materials.
- Stakeholder engagement and partnerships.
- Corporate participation in public health promotion.
- Volunteer mobilization.
- Community environmental clean-up activities.

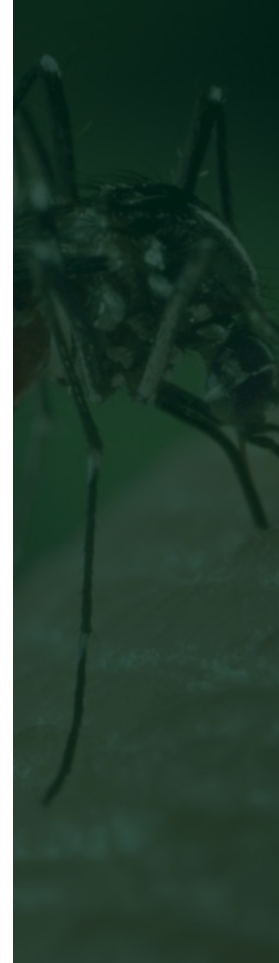
Each outreach has reinforced one simple truth:

World **Mosquito** Day - 2024

As Nigerians, we see and feel the impact of climate change every day.

The global theme for World **Mosquito** Day 2024 was “Accelerating the fight against malaria for a more equitable world.” Aligning directly with the World Health Organization’s mission, our team took targeted action to bridge the gap in healthcare access and environmental sanitation.

As a company committed to improving lives and transforming Nigeria, we take pride in proactively creating value that will leave a lasting legacy, reshaping our communities, our environment, and our planet with sustainability as one of the core values driving our company.

Our 2024 deployment combined professional environmental management, community sensitization, and direct family support to build a comprehensive shield against malaria with Over 50 Households, Over 50 Liters of Larvicide Applied, Over 200 Care Packages Distributed.

What We Accomplished on the Field:

Phase 1: Waste and Drainage Clearing

We mobilized equipment and manpower to clear blocked drainage systems, remove accumulated organic refuse, and educate households on practical ways to eliminate structural water retention.

Phase 2: Breeding Ground Elimination

We deployed eco-friendly, public health-approved larvicides and residual sprays across open drains, standing pools, and dense vegetation within the host community to break the mosquito breeding cycle.

Phase 3: Immediate Household Protection

We directly gifted families with long-lasting insecticidal nets, WHO-approved indoor mosquito repellents, and essential household food supplies.

Winning the battle against mosquito-borne diseases requires a strategy that addresses both the symptoms and the root causes.

Our 2025 deployment focuses on a four-tiered tactical approach:

- ***Grassroots Sensitization:***

Empowering local communities with actionable knowledge on waste management, stagnant water prevention, and personal protection.

- ***Environmental Management:***

Clearing choked drainage systems, managing overflowing refuse points, and eliminating the structural water-logging that turns communities into high-risk breeding zones.

- ***Eco-Friendly Pest Control:***

Deploying advanced, environmentally responsible vector control and larvicide to eliminate breeding sites without harming local ecosystems.

- ***Direct Family Intervention:***

Distributing long-lasting insecticidal nets (LLINs) for high-risk neighbourhoods alongside edibles.
